In preparation for your time overseas, you'll begin discerning what God might be calling you to and what obstacles might stand in your way.



PRE-FIELD MENTORSHIP

In preparation for your time overseas, you'll begin discerning what God might be calling you to and what obstacles might stand in your way.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT IN PRE-FIELD

MENTORING

You'll meet virtually with a missions mentor for approximately 90 minutes every other week as they help you raise financial support, instill long-term missions principles, prepare you for 3 months overseas, and pray for you.

Your mentor is specifically gifted at mentoring, has a heart for young adults, and wants to help you identify God's calling on your life.

TEAM CALLS

You'll meet virtually with your team, grow in relationship, pray together, and hear more about the vision of the Overseas Missions Mentorship.

You'll cover important logistical information, such as packing lists, travel information, security measures, and cultural information.

SUPPORT RAISING

Our vision is to help you overcome the fear and obstacle of raising support, while also raising the necessary funds to go through our program. You will receive first-class training, a proven and effective strategy, and a mentor to walk through the process with you.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT OVERSEAS

EXCURSIONS

Each excursion is uniquely designed to expose you to different aspects of the life of a missionary. Depending on your location, you may experience a 3 – 5 day home stay with a local family, a trip to the desert, a hike to a rural, unengaged village, or a week in a fishing community.

BASE TOWN

You'll live in an apartment with fellow teammates, buy groceries from the local market, cook international food, and build relationships with locals. You'll learn what it could look like for you, with your skills, talents, and desires, to live in a foreign culture.

TRAINING

You'll receive extensive training in a number of areas, including language, security, culture, religion, history, and technology. You'll learn how to learn a foreign language through a variety of methods, how to stay secure in a country where it is illegal to evangelize, the basic elements of local culture and religion, and how to effectively communicate with your support team and family.

MENTORING

The backbone of your overseas mentorship is the relationship you have with our permanent, long-term missions staff. While doing life with our staff and meeting one-on-one with your personal mentor, they will help you process your excursions, discern where God is leading you, and help you overcome any specific fears and insecurities that arise while overseas.

GRADUATE MENTORSHIP

Gain clarity and confidence around your calling into missions as you debrief your overseas experience, identify your next steps, and create a plan to help you get there.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT IN GRADUATE MENTORING

MENTORING

You'll meet virtually with your mentor 60 – 90 minutes every other week as you debrief your experience overseas, adjust back to life at home, talk about practical next steps, and put together a plan for how to step into the calling God has put on your life.

AGENCY CONNECTIONS

If you choose to pursue a life of overseas missions, we'll help you understand what to look for in a sending agency, provide recommendations that match your needs, offer personal connections to an extensive list of partnering agencies, and walk you through the application process.

CLARITY AROUND YOUR CALLING

Our mentorship is designed to help you confidently answer the question, "Am I called to serve long-term among the unreached?" Whether you're immediately heading back overseas, putting together a 5-year plan to get overseas, or becoming actively involved in missions from home, we are confident you'll have clarity around whatever it is that God is calling you into.

What is the primary religion of the basetowns?

In North Africa, the primary religion is Islam. In Asia, there are a few different religions, including Buddhism, Islam, Hinduism and tribal religions.

How safe is the overseas mentorship?

We strategicially and intentionally select locations that will allow you to experience life inside the 10/40 Window while also providing an environment that is safe to explore. While there is no guarantee of safety, we implement extremely conservative security measures to help ensure your safety.

How many people are on a team?

There is a wide range based on the semester. Our fall and spring teams have anywhere between 5 and 10 students per team. The summer teams are much larger, usually between 12 and 15 students.

How long is the program?

The entire program is 9 months. The first 3 months and last 3 months are conducted virtually and only require a commitment of 2 - 3 hours per week. The overseas portion lasts 85 days.

How much does it cost?

The minimum amount a fall or spring student has to raise is \$7,500.

The minimum amount a summer student has to raise is \$8,000.

What does the cost cover?

The amount you raise will cover everything from the moment you get on a plane until the moment that you return stateside, with the exception of souvenirs and personal effects. This includes, but is not limited to, pre-field training and preparation, roundtrip airfare, lodging, food, travel, insurance, cross-cultural excursions, and technology.
